They left as anglers—confident, clear-eyed, and casting with purpose.

Anni Shores, our RWFFA guide school lead and longtime anchor on the Madison, has been guiding these waters for 35 years. As I was guiding during our walk-wade session, I picked up on the different inner voices our anglers were having conversations with:

- "Well, I made a perfect cast and no fish."
- "I know there are fish here—Kitty just landed one!"
- And then, from Anni, like a steady drumbeat of belief: "I believe I'm going to catch a fish with every drift."

That shift—from doubt to belief—is everything.

When you begin to expect something good from the water, your posture changes. Your cast relaxes. Your senses expand.

You notice the way the current pushes under the cut bank.

You see the shadow of a trout tucked behind a submerged rock.

You feel when it's time to move upstream.

There's something holy in that mindset. Something that feels like grace.

I hold close a definition I once read from Pope Francis:

"Hope is a virtue of the heart that never gives up."

Hope on the river doesn't mean ignoring the hard moments—the tangles, missed sets, fish that spook. It means staying connected to the possibility in every drift. That mindset is something our Back 2 Basics anglers carried home with them. Not just better casters, but more present ones.

Because fly fishing, after all, isn't just about fish.

It's about the **moments that teach us how to see differently**, how to pay attention, how to stay open to what's next.

If you feel that tug—if something in you stirs reading this—you might be ready to join us. The 2026 season will be here before you know it. The Madison will still be flowing. And we'll be there, ready to welcome you.

Until then, keep casting.
