Permit Quest Report San Pedro, Belize

During the first part of the week, the Permit were hiding. These women caught everything else and had a great time doing it. Tarpon, Jacks, Bonefish, and Snapper were all brought to the boat. We had some 'long distance 'releases' including a 40-60 pound Tarpon (according to our guides) that claimed victory when there was no 'Bow to the King'.

Later in the week, Liz landed a Permit and followed up the next day with two Tarpon in the boat. She spent that day with Elese who also put two Tarpon in the boat! The Bonefish were plentiful and everyone caught a lot of fish throughout their stay.

The camaraderie and encouragement this group brought to the week is amazing. Three of the ladies met here last year and became great friends who chat at home often. They all booked the same week this year and have had a great time together while welcoming new friends into the mix. It fosters such a supportive, fun environment for our catered dinners and breakfasts - laughing together. It also creates an amazing environment to grow in your fly-fishing each day.

Travel Update- Delta airlines continues to offer safe travel by holding empty seats to create proper spacing and offering all travelers their own sanitation wipes when they board. Temperatures are checked and proof of a negative test moves you quickly on to your next flight over to San Pedro. We're monitoring the temperatures of our angling guests each day and having dinners catered each day to ensure all stay healthy and safe!



Tarpon Quest

May 15-22, 2021 or May 14-21, 2022

Stable conditions and a sea full of 'Poons! Our resident tarpon live around Ambergris Caye all year, but then in May the migratory tarpon come in and stay until about mid-October. It seems like all the tarpon get excited with a full house. A great time to up your chances for landing this magnificent creature. This is the pinnacle for many fly anglers and a great time to make it happen.

Resident Tarpon range from 20-60 lbs and the migratory tarpon usually average up to 120 lbs but we've seen some larger fish come through. These 'big girls' are an amazing pursuit and something folks plan their travel around each year. We're excited to host a women's event in Belize; it will be a fun time showing the world how the ladies can land the big ones! Of course Permit, Bonefish and more also await!


