Paradise Valley, Montana The Yellowstone River

Yep, another bucket list fly-fishing destination. There is just something about Montana that reaches your soul and helps you find peace at the core of life. The Yellowstone is over 700 miles

in its entirety but the 100 miles that runs between the Gallatin and northern Absorka mountains is the most popular flyfishing stretch. Paradise Valley sits just north of Yellowstone National Park where the river flows over those famous 109 and 308 foot drops called Upper and Lower Yellowstone Falls. The entire region is home to elk, deer, eagles, buffallo, brown and black bear and of course, big Brown Trout and the native Yellowstone Cutthroat trout!


