

Lori Ann's ability to keep us grounded and moving toward our dreams and goals weaves its way into the fabric of Reel Women Adventures. *Cast to Your Dreams....* Coming home from the river or the salt flats, a feeling of inspiration takes thoughts and concepts from 'dreams' to action. In the weeks and months that follow.... It isn't always easy.

We sat down with April Vokey who has pioneered influential podcasts, TV shows and her newest

Anchored Outdoors subscriptions to share her version of inspiration to action.

April guided for many years before landing Shorelines on the World Fishing Network. As she worked on episodes each week she found amazing stories and people she wanted the fly-fishing world to know; but the restrictions of the network and production made that difficult. April Vokey's podcast concept was born and today includes a long list of influential people and their stories available on her website.

When we asked April how some of these stories and adventures have influenced her, she replied. "They all influence me. Its humbling to sit down with people in their 80's and 90's and hear about their stories. Crawling across the grass on your belly to escape a concentration camp, leaving your family. I am so young, and have so much to learn."

April's podcasts share the spirit of what so many of us enjoy in the flyfishing world. These characters and stories change us, influence our lives. So many walks of life are melded into a days outing and adventure that you didn't know existed that morning.

Then there is the travel. "I never came back the same from any trip." April will tell you that being around different people will change you. "Seeing poverty made me reflect on how much we have and how fortunate I am."



All of these steps and turns in the journey have enabled April to share the stories many of us wouldn't have the chance to hear. An outsider with their own dreams might look at April and all she has achieved with intimidation. Her advice, "You don't know if you don't try. You won't evolve. You have to take the first step." Her ideas have certainly evolved into an influential offering for our hearts to grow and dream from.

Bonefish, permit and tarpon live full time around the waters that surround Ambergris Caye, Belize. We call this our "Permit Quest," but of course all species are here for you.



We have our Chef's come in and cook up mouth watering local Belizean style dinners. Delcia and Norma are a big reason so many of our anglers return for Permit Quest! We'll make sure some lobster and local San Pedro flavor are experienced after landing fish all day! Plan to escape next years winter on our warm sunny beaches and flats with Reel Women Adventures.

Casting Tips...Cast Away! By Lori-Ann Murphy

Warming temperatures and longer days are sure welcomed as summer approaches. The family's fly fishing pursuits can be shared during this time at home and as we venture outside. Like the robins singing about big fat worms you'll be so proud to see fly lines reaching new limits. What age can we start teaching? As soon as they show an interest but the real learning seems to happen when the child can

keep focused for fifteen minutes. And focused on fun things, like - "Let's hit the target!" And introducing how to land a fish by keeping the rod tip up or guess what? The line breaks and the lunker fish is gone. It's nice to find rods that are shorter - 7 or 8 feet long as opposed to a nine foot rod. You can have the child use two hands on the rod grip, one with the thumb on top and second at the very end of the grip - both thumbs aligned. This way they get to feel the rod bend with the stops and get that "sling shot" action that is so much fun. Teaching the child about target is a great way to keep them focused and also rewarded. All casts are great but some are FANTASTIC! Keep the fancy words for later years and use simple words like "slow-fast," "snappy stop." Who get's to be the fish? Keep those fly lines cleaned after all the fun and then it's time for a field trip to the water. Have fun!






Anchored Outdoors

Reel Belize

We're pretty excited to see Lori-Ann's new film on Reel Belize going live with April Vokey on Anchored Outdoors this week! This piece was filmed right before the Covid lockdowns started; perhaps the weather was cluing us in on things to come.

Many of you have been a part of the Reel Women Family and enjoyed womens trips for years. Those will always continue but you've asked for couples and family style trips too. Reel Belize is here to serve and our English speaking guides, trained by Lori-Ann, will ensure your day on the flats is everything you want it to be!

The History of Reel Belize

While Lori-Ann was at El Pescador, in Belize, she was featured on Buccaneer's and Bones for two seasons and the lodge received the Orvis International Lodge of the year. In 2015 the Orvis company awarded Lori-Ann and Reel Women with the prestigious "Breaking Barriers Award". By 2017 she had a trade license and began using the great relationships she has with the local guide community to offer world class fly fishing in San Pedro. In 2018 Reel Belize became official Tour operator. We are now booking custom trips for all levels of anglers that match their abilities and fishing desires. For those that have asked, we can help balance the trip requirements of your significant other or family too!

Destination Overview

Reel Belize is about the custom experience. Your days on the salt flats are limited each year and we want them to be everything you've been dreaming of. Our residents include Permit, Tarpon, Bonefish, Snook, Jacks, Snapper, Barracuda and more. In May the larger migratory Tarpon come to San Pedro, staying until October. During this time it's easy to "Bow to the King" ...or Queens over 100lbs.

Depending on what you want to fish for, we put you in the closest lodging option -matching your flyfishing desires, accommodation requests and budget. San Pedro is a small but growing town

with some great island culture, activities and people. You'll get to experience the 'local feel' and wonderful people after landing your catch!

Balance – Like other flyfishing options, we have the standard 6 night / 5 day packages available for you to chase those fish and hit it hard. We're also located on the Great Belize Barrier Reef and warm Caribbean Ocean and our partners can get you and your family into some of the best snorkeling and diving in the world. Other activities include Bote stand-up paddle boards, kayaking, day trips to the Hol Chan Marine



Reserve or in the Tres Cocos area where marine life abounds. We can help your family find Spa options, Mayan Ruins, cave tubing, a trip to "The Great Blue Hole", snorkeling, sealife and more.

The Fishing

Belize was the first country to introduce "Catch and Release" practices for bonefish, permit and tarpon. From over ten years of protection, we now see the results. An increase in size of individual fish as well as a healthy population throughout the growth phase. The flats of Belize are healthy and continue to produce additional opportunity.

Permit

Belize is known as the Permit Capital of the world! Most of our fishing is done from a skiff and you'll see schools of permit swimming by or singles tailing on shallow flats. We've had many anglers find their first Permit here in Belize -and many anglers who make regular trips to Belize for the thrill of landing illusive Permit.

Tarpon

Our year round resident Tarpon range from the baby Tarpon up to 80 pounds. The large migratory Tarpon arrive in May and stay until mid-October. These fish average 100-180 pounds and we've seen some bigger fish come through over the years.



Bonefish

All year long, these fish are plentiful and fun on our flats. Over the last 10 years Belize has implemented catch and release programs which have really helped our fish population. We now

have very large bonefish residents that rival Christmas Island or Hawaiian bonefish.

You can also find shots at Snook, Barracuda, Jacks, Ladyfish, Snapper, Cobia and Triggerfish. Watching a Barracuda get aggressive and slam your fly on the salt flats is an adrenaline rush you won't forget!



Reel Belize is all about helping you build the custom experience for your group to target the species they'd like, the number of days you can stay and bring non-fishing family or friends for a fun vacation for all. Book a custom trip with us before year end (for this year or next) and only 25% down is required. The balance will be due 90 days before your arrival in Belize!

Cast to Your Dreams!

Book a 2020 or 2021 trip with us before the end of the year and we'll require only 25% down. The balance due 90 days before arrival. If your plans change due to Covid or any other reason you can reschedule. That means you can put your down payment toward any Reel Women Adventure trip with open space. We also offer Global Rescue's Cancel For Any Reason Trip Insurance. We want to see you back on the water, casting to your dreams!
