Some Guidelines for fly-fishing from a drift boatBy Lori-Ann Murphy

Most drift boats are set up with an angler in the bow, the guide rowing in the middle and the second angler in the stern - with the anchor and all the other stuff your flyline can find. The bow of the boat is generally considered to be the "advantage" since you are placing your fly before the boat reaches the fish. However, the back of the boat can be fun, it's just a different game. If you think you are hiding in the back you are wrong. Guides are looking backward just as often as they are looking forward. But you do have an opportunity to place your fly with precision. Anglers should not cast at the same time unless they are in sink and aware of each others cast. Guides will often move the boat to work currents as the path is not a straight line. Be aware of the geography and each other and you will save a tremendous amount of what I call "fish down time." Tangled lines and no flies on the water is not fishing. But it is a good time to look up and see all the beauty! Chances are an Osprey will fly over and show you its fish. Stay playful and observant. It's a short cast from the drift boat, so take your time and put it where you want it to go.
