Changed your perspective? Inspired you to find a new favorite place in the world? We've enjoyed standing together and inspiring each other!

My angling roots started early, growing up in a "fishing" family. My dad insisted that I learn to fly

fish as I started showing a passion for bugs as a toddler. This led to my first foray into fly fishing out West, in Grand Teton National Park. A few summers later, we spent several weeks in Eastern Idaho and my mom discovered that there was a company called "Reel Women" and booked me my first guided trip with them. It was the first time ANY of us had seen female-led fly fishing anywhere- and this was pre-internet! It was one of the most memorable experiences of my life (I even remember getting an Oreo milkshake afterwards) and laid a foundation for a path that I am still on today. Lori-Ann's female empowerment in the sport of fly fishing has certainly helped me to "Cast to my dreams". I now manage the Orvis store in one of the most highly-trafficked fly fishing areas in the country and fish 4+ days a week.



I have done a little traveling to fish, but the bulk of it has stayed in the GYE, or Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. The more I go out and explore on my own around here, the less I want to leave. I feel like I could spend every day off here doing something new and still never scratch the surface. Fly fishing has led me to lakes, rivers, streams, backpacking, on boat trips and



beyond. The diversity of settings that it can be done in never cease to amaze me. Spending a little time in Belize has me yearning to learn more about salt though! My husband is from New Orleans, so redfish have always been at the top of the list too. Opportunities to fish and spend time with family are the best.

I am still the most inspired by my backyard as far as places to go fish. It was the first place I ever fly fished and will likely be the last. While dreams of Dorado and big browns in New Zealand often dance in my head, the cutthroat down the road is what gets the most attention. Appreciating and loving where you live, adapting to whatever circumstances those are, and getting to know your local watershed have helped me so much as an angler and I can't thank Reel Women enough for their courage and inspiration to get here!

Maggie has a masters degree in Entomology with an acquatic insect education specialty. She'll be teaching the entomology section of our Back to Basics class in Jackson Hole Wyoming this month. migratory Tarpon have entered Belizean waters along with the resident Tarpon. What this means is that

there are Tarpon from 15 - 200 lbs out there to meet your cast. Shallow water casts using floating lines and intermediate lines for the deeper cruisers - show them the fur or feathers and get grabbed! Bonefish, Permit and Tarpon live in Belizean waters that surround Ambergris Caye all year. San Pedro's waters are well known for the possible SLAM. Let it be yours!

Our chefs will be in to cater Belizean cuisine and Lori-Ann will do clinics each day to focus on the casting components needed for these large Tarpon. You'll also have the opportunity for some one-on-one clinic time to ask questions and fine tune your cast on any fly-fishing pursuit. These dates fall under a great new moon and the big girls will be well settled in after their migration to Belize for the summer. Amazing Tarpon fishing awaits! Come join us for 7 nights and 5 days of fly-fishing.
